Game: Can you make k with playdoh/ flour/sand? Can you read these words? nip, pet, hat</p>	<p>Phonics: Practice saying the sound e Think of words that begin with e- egg, elephant, envelope, elbow, Write e 5 times in copy Draw 3 things that begin with e- from above list Game: I spy-find some objects in your house-s, a, t, l, p, n,c,k,e Can you read these words? net, hit, cat</p>	<p>Good Friday! Practice saying the sound h Think of words that begin with h-hip, hot, hug, heart, happy, hammer Make an Easter picture- Easter eggs, Easter bunny, eggs in a basket Easter Story https://m.youtube.com/watch?v=HL8R158Ujp4</p>
<p>SESE: Living and non-Living Find some animal toys/animal and objects that are not animals-e.g. car, ball, blocks etc. Talk about how the animals differ to the objects. How many legs do the animals have, have they a tail, long/short, big or small?</p>	<p>PE: Play outside. If the sun is shining, make some animal shadows with your hands- snake, elephant, duck, bird, crocodile insects- spider, butterfly Can you make any other ones?</p>	<p>Science: Talk about the materials the three little pigs used to build their houses. What material was best to build the house? Which one could the big bad wolf not blow down? Art: Make a sign to keep the wolf out of the Three little pigs' houses!</p>	<p>Science: Magnets: Can you find a magnet in your house? (Often clip of phone cover) What sticks to it? (spoon, coin, paperclip, nails, pin) Make 2 groups: things that are magnetic and things that are not.</p>	<p>PE: Hop like bunny 10 times. Can you jump high like a bunny 5 times? Music/Dance: Hippy Hop: Easter bunny song https://m.youtube.com/watch?v=4hfV3ubcnqM</p>
<p>Maths : Can you count the steps as you walk upstairs? How many steps are there? What step comes after 6? What step comes after 8? Write number 1-draw 1 balloon, apple, ball Write no. 2: Draw 2 lollipops, plates, oranges Ext: Can you write up to 5?</p>	<p>Maths: Counting tennis:-Count every second number with your child 1,2,3, 4... Who can get to 15 first? Start at 3 count up to 15 Ask your child to build tower with 5 blocks and another with 7 blocks. Build more towers. Which one is shorter/taller? Ext: How many blocks do I have altogether if I put them together?</p>	<p>Maths: Count to 15 tapping your nose, shoulders, knees and ears. Write the numbers 1-6 cut them out. Can you sequence them 1-6. Game: Using 1-6 Child closes eyes, take number away. What number is missing? Ext: Point to the number that comes after 2..., 4..., 5 What number comes before 3</p>	<p>Maths: Can we make a double? Get 1 spoon and add another (1and1 makes 2) Get 2 forks and another 2 (2 and 2 makes 4) Get 3 knives and another 3 (3 and 3 makes 6.) Game: Matching pairs-write the no's 1-6 two times, cut out and face down. Try find a match!</p>	<p>Maths: Easter Egg hunt: You can hide some eggs or toys. How many eggs/ toys did you find? Make some chocolate nests-cooking chocolate, cornflakes/rice krispies etc. Count out the bun cases. How many nests did you make? Can you put 1,2,3..more marshmallows/chocolates on each nest?</p>
