Ask your child to make a set with 4 items. Next ask them to make another set with 3 items. How many have you if we put the two sets together? (Say yes you are right you had 4 and added 3 more so now you have 7 because 4 and 3 makes 7). Repeat with a different number of items each time. Number should never be more than 10.</p>	<p><b>Maths:</b>  <b>Counting:</b> Let's count backwards today! Can you count from 20 all the way back to 1?
