Can you write them when called out?</p> <p>Bingo: play with parent/siblings- write out the letters on s,a,t,l,p,n ,v,b,j on card/paper, cut them out On another piece of paper write out any 6 of the letters. Bingo master calls out the sound, whoever has all the letter checked first is the winner and is bingo master next time.</p>
<p>Geography: Living in the Community People who take care of us -Doctor, nurse, Garda, Fire fighters, Lollipop lady, Teacher Can you think of anyone else? Talk about how they keep us safe and take care of us.</p> <p>Draw a picture of your favourite one.</p>	<p>PE: Play outside. Ball skills- Bounce a ball with 2 hands 10 times Bounce it with one hand 10 times and then with the other hand Bounce the ball between both hands 10 times? Can you throw the ball to someone? Can you catch it?</p>	<p>Science: Lifecycle of the chicken Watch this short video about the lifecycle of Penny the chicken https://m.youtube.com/watch?v=pozsn2f6M3Y</p> <p>Can you remember how many days it takes for the egg to hatch?</p> <p>Draw a picture Penny sitting on the nest waiting for the egg to hatch.</p>	<p>Music: Find the object Hide an object in a room (behind a cushion, a picture, in a press etc) Play the clapping game by changing the tempo of your clap to help your child find the object- Go fast when they are close to the object and clap slowly when they are far away from it. <p>Maths : Counting: Count every second number with your child, whoever reaches the final number wins! Start on 2...stop on 16 Start on 4...stop on 12 Start on 5...stop on 17</p>	<p>Maths: Counting: Can you count from 5-0 Can you walk up the stairs to step no. 6, then count backwards coming down- 6,5,4,3,2,1,0</p>	<p>Maths: Counting: Start at 3 and count up to as far as you can! What number comes after 6, 4, 7, 9, 10. Making Sets: Find 5 toys/blocks/cars for your child.</p>	<p>Maths: Counting: Can you count from 7-0. Make a set of 7 objects/toys, then start taking one away every time, then say the number. 7,6,5,4,3,2,1,0 Ext: Can you count from 10-0?</p>	<p>Maths: Counting: Start at the number 5, count up to 20. Write the no’s 1-6 on card, cut them out. Sequence no’s 1-6. Point to the number that comes before 5, 3, 6, 4, 5, 2</p>

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<p>Can you write the numbers 1,2,3,4,5,6</p> <p>Take a look at this video that explains ordinal numbers 1st, 2nd, 3rd https://m.youtube.com/watch?v=ef-D9B8EOFQ</p>	<p>Can you write the no's 1-6 on card, cut them out and sequence them 1,2,3,4,5,6</p> <p>Game: Find some toys that move, have a race. Which toy came 1st?/2nd?/3rd?</p>	<p>Draw 2 circles- put 4 toys in one circle and one in the other circle and say, yes 4 and 1 makes 5,(4+1=5) Can you make $3+2=5$, $2+3=5$, $1+4=5$, $0+5=5$, $5+0=5$. Can you find something that is lighter than chair?</p>	<p>Ext: Can you write the numbers 1-10</p> <p>Matching Game: Using the cards you have made, can you put the correct amount of objects (make a set) with each number?</p>
<p>Story: Little Red Riding Hood Listen to the story https://youtu.be/LDMWJCrDVMl</p> <p>Draw or paint a picture of Little Red Riding Hood</p>	<p>Art: Design a WANTED sign for the big bad wolf! What does he look like? Does he have sharp teeth? A long nose? Big eyes? Is there a reward for someone that finds him? Don't forget to put a contact number on it!</p>	<p>Story time: Find you favourite book and read with someone Or Tell your family your news!</p>	<p>Lego: Build a wall for Humpty Dumpty. What could you build to help Humpty Dumpty sit on the wall safely? A Chair/ seat?</p>	<p>SPHE: Healthy Eating If you were to make a basket of food for your sick Granny, what foods will make her feel better? Fruit, soup, water, sandwich? If the weather is nice have a picnic outside or inside if it is raining!</p>
